

GreyGreed Tank Tools - Engineering Log 1.0.5

Release type: retail patch rebuild with Dungeon Finder / instance-group recognition and tank-marker prompt polish.

Work completed

- Fixed Dungeon Finder and instance-party detection for Tank Tools group-state checks.
- Updated auto-show logic so the panel can activate in Dungeon Finder / instance parties when the selected auto-show mode allows it.
- Updated permission messaging so valid instance groups are not treated as solo or “not in raid.”
- Preserved raid authority gating for raid-sized groups, while allowing five-player party and Dungeon Finder panel use.
- Updated the tank marker prompt and preview so MT/OT marker assignments display actual raid marker icons instead of token text such as {star} or {triangle}.
- Rebuilt the missing 1.0.5 artifacts as actual downloadable files, not a stale 1.0.4 package.

Implementation notes

- Introduced shared party/raid/instance-group detection helpers in the UI and tank-marker paths.
- Registered additional group/zone events for rechecking state after Dungeon Finder transitions: LFG_ROLE_UPDATE and ZONE_CHANGED_NEW_AREA.
- Kept tank marking as a prompt-and-click flow; the addon does not silently apply markers without player confirmation.
- Kept callouts on the secure macro button path and did not add direct SendChatMessage calls to the callout UI path.

Validation summary

- Version strings synchronized to 1.0.5 across TOCs and runtime version registration.
- Retail TOC remains 120007.
- TOC path audit passed after normalizing Windows-style TOC paths during validation.
- No stale settings.lua is shipped.
- No direct SetRaidTarget calls found.
- No UnitHealth or UnitPower arithmetic paths were introduced.
- Settings helper forward-reference audit passed.
- ZIP integrity passed for the add-on ZIP and combined bundle ZIP.

Smoke-test checklist

- Install fresh by replacing Interface/AddOns/GreyGreed_TankTools.
- Enter a Dungeon Finder group with Auto-show set to Party/Raid and confirm the panel opens.
- Enter a normal party and confirm the panel no longer reports “not in raid.”
- Enter a raid without assist and confirm raid-authority controls remain gated.

- Open Diagnostics > Mark Tank Preview and confirm selected MT/OT markers display as marker icons.
- With Automatically mark tanks enabled, join a group out of combat and confirm the tank-marker prompt appears after roles populate.
